Here is **the latest on the visas’ situation.**

Our attorney talked to the Immigration department and was informed that the process that used to take only six months is now being delayed to more than a year. Due to this delay, we will not be able to travel to Brazil on our mission trip scheduled for March/2008. Please pray that the Lord will give us the visas in time for us to prepare for the next mission trip in November 2008.

We have had wonderful opportunities to present our ministry for financial partnership the beginning of this year. It has been great seeing our children talking to students about life in Brazil and answering questions the youth have about missions. The Lord has blessed us with one more church and two more individuals that added us for monthly support. Our **monthly support level is now in 67%**. We are so grateful to our faithful God and all churches and friends who are partnering with us.

Important facts on Angola: Capital Luanda, Population: 13,000,000, Official language: Portuguese

After 27 years of civil war taking the lives of over 500,000 people in the 1990s, Angola is now being reconstructed. Even though Communism almost destroyed the country, it failed to eradicate Christianity that is growing slowly in the midst of appalling suffering and deprivation.
